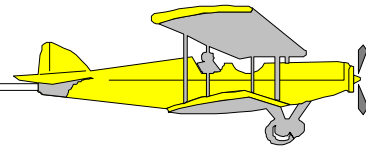

Note: The tower at University Park Airport (UNV) will be in operation requiring radio communication (128.475) if you choose to fly through their airspace which covers a 4.5 NM radius from UNV to an altitude of 3500 MSL.

Directions (if traveling by land)

From Lewistown - follow 322 to Potters Mills and take Rt 144 toward Old Fort/Centre Hall. Turn left onto Airport Road (second road on the left) – Airport is on the left.
From State College – follow Route 45E to Old Fort/Centre Hall. Turn right on Route 144. Turn right at the first Road (Airport Road) – Airport will be on the left.

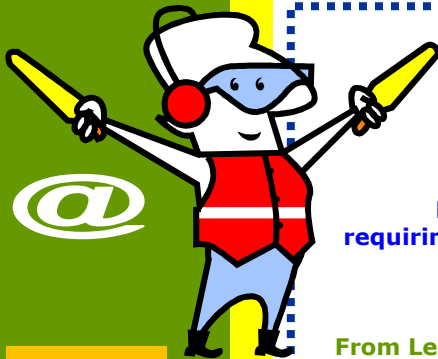

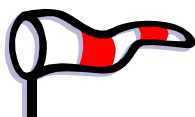
